97% of Year 1 pupils achieved the Phonic Screen, National 81%. 98% of Year 2 pupils achieved the Phonic Screen, National 91%

Foundation Stage: 87% of pupils achieved GLD (Good Level of Development) 27% above the national for 2016 and an increase of 12% from 2015.

Department of Education information: 'Because of the changes, figures for 2016 are not comparable to those for earlier years. The expectations for pupils at the end of KS1 and 2 have been raised. Given the differences in the curriculum and assessments, levels are not comparable with scaled scores or teacher assessment outcomes.'
