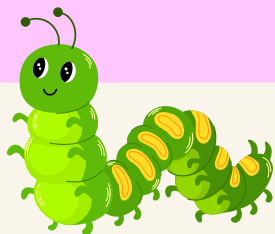


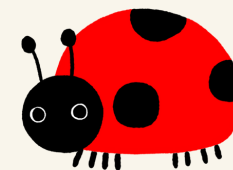

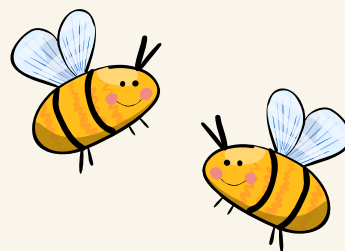
Homework

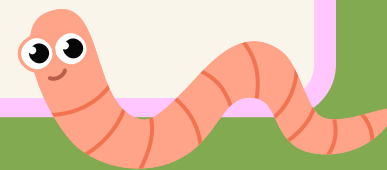
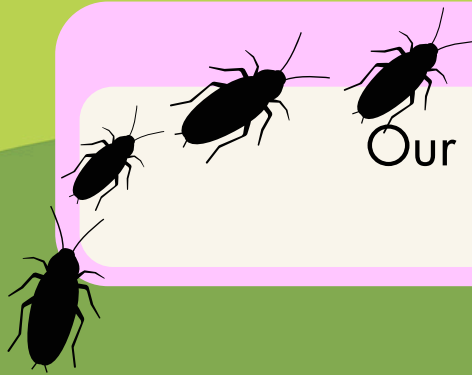



Friendship Week
