Dear Parents/Carers,

Over the last two weeks we have seen an increase in absences due to illness. Many of these absences appear to be cough/colds/sore throat and flu like symptoms.

Symptoms of COVID-19, flu and common respiratory infections include:

Continuous cough, high temperature, shortness of breath, tiredness/lack of energy, muscle aches and pains, loss of appetite, headaches, sore throat, stuffy/runny nose, diarrhoea and feeling or being sick.

We would like to clarify the current COVID-19 guidelines: If a child has tested positive they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after they took the test. After this time if they feel well enough and do not have a temperature, they can return to school as the risk of passing the infection onto others is much lower. Please contact the school to inform us of your child's absence.

Children who live with someone who has tested positive should continue to attend school as normal.

### ATTENDANCE

A reminder that all planned absence must be requested by parents, please. This includes absence for reasons you expect to be denied, such as for holidays or family celebrations. It is essential and lawful for schools to know where a child is if they are not at school and we follow investigative procedures when absence is not explained, as outlined in our Attendance Policy. **Please be aware that children are very honest about where they are going/have been if a term-time holiday or celebration is planned**. Where an alternative reason is given for absence in such cases (e.g. reported as illness), the school will follow this up and could result in authorised absence marks being changed to unauthorised.

It is appropriate at this point, to remind all parents of the law and of the possibility of penalty fines for unauthorised absence, with an extract from our Attendance Policy: Unauthorised absence may result in the school referring to the Local Authority for sanctions and/or legal proceedings. This may include issuing each parent with a Penalty Notice for £120, reduced to £60 if paid within 21 days or referring the matter to the Magistrates Court, whereby each parent may receive a fine of up to £2500 and/or up to 3 months in prison. If a parent is found guilty in court, they will receive a criminal conviction.
