### PUPIL SUPERVISION

### CHILDREN'S BELONGINGS

Please ensure all of your child's belongings are marked with their name and new class – NOT their initials or the name of an older sibling that has now left the school. Please provide your child with a coat, even if they come to school by car, as they will be going out to play in most weathers. Do not provide your child with a bulky backpack as we do not have the space to accommodate them on the school pegs.

## WATER BOTTLES

Please purchase your child a water bottle for £1 at the school office. Children need to take home their water bottles on a daily basis. Please wash them thoroughly and refill them for the next day. Children may top up their bottles from the school water coolers during the school day.

School swimming hats are also available at reception for £1 each, all in various colours.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please ensure your child wears the correct school uniform. Children not wearing the correct school uniform will receive a reminder slip from their class teacher. White polo shirts only should be worn - not shirts. Children should only wear the school sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo. Navy cardigans, tank tops or other sweatshirts are not acceptable. All children must wear black school shoes and dark or medium grey shorts, trousers, skirts, pinafores or culottes.
